### CURRENT TRADE CONDITIONS.

OMTARIO.

Under the influence of a moderate demand, the lumber market maintains a steady tone. Prospects for the future have been improved by the better outlook for the crops. The bulletin issued by the Ontario Department of Agriculture calls attention to the damage to fall wheat by winter killing, but since the beginning of May the weather has been favorable for the recuperation of the crop and the latest reports indicate that many of the fields are making an encouraging recovery. A large yield of grain will likely bring about a heavy demand for lumber in the fall. Present shipments to the United States are not all that might be desired, but dealers report a very satisfactory local trade, with no signs of an early falling off. There riay be a readjustment of prices after mid-summer on account of the usual inactivity preceding the Presidential election across the border, but the general average is not likely to be reduced materially. Hardwor is are meeting with a ready sale. The old stock is practically cleaned out and dealers have experienced some difficulty in filling orders for certain sixes. Soft elm and birch lead in point of activity. An increased inquiry for beech is reported. One year ago this lumber was selling at \$14 for log run, while sales have recently been made at \$18. It has been found to be a very satisfactory substitute for certain higherpriced woods.

QUEBEC AND NEW BRUNSWICK.

The spruce lumber market is still in an unsettled condition. Some shipments are being made to the United States, but there is very little buying for the British market. The price of merchantable spruce logs is now about \$9 per thousand, and that of lumber \$11 per thousand. This is a decline of over \$2 as compared with the prices ruling one year ago. There is practically no demand for logs at the present time, and mill men who contracted for their supply some time ago at higher prices will sustain heavy losses unless conditio is improve. The financial embarrassment of a large Fredericton lumberman, referred to elsewhere, has emphasized the necessity of taking every precaution against possible loss. There are two factors, however, that are favorable to the lumber market. The first is that the stock of dry lumber carried over from last year was very small, and the second is the probability that a large percentage of the logs taken out the past winter will not reach the mills this year.
