

54. The two countries expressed their interest in holding a "Mexican Radio Week in Canada" and a "Canadian Radio Week in Mexico".

Contacts for this purpose will be established through diplomatic channels.

55. The two Parties will produce special programmes to mark each country's national holiday: the 1st of July for Canada and the 16th of September for Mexico.

The details will be determined through diplomatic channels.

56. The two Parties will study the possibility of co-producing radio programmes on culture, science, and the arts, and exchanging radio programming on a systematic basis.

The details will be determined through diplomatic channels.

Television

57. The two Parties will study the possibility of exchanging technical personnel for the purpose of their taking specialised training in television production and administration.

The number of technical personnel, their names and curricula vitae, the dates of their visits, and other details will be made known through diplomatic channels.

58. The two Parties will study the possibility of exchanging television programmes and times, and will for this purpose provide the corresponding catalogues.
