# ÉCHANGES "GO" ÉCHANGES

### WHAT IS IT?

GO provides young people with an opportunity to participate in a cultural experience and acquire new skills that are complementary to their education and work experience.

Exchanges are arranged in all fields of education including agricultural production, agronomy, food technology and horticulture.

Participating countries include France, Belgium, Switzerland, Germany, Luxembourg, the Netherlands and Australia.

## HOW LONG CAN I STAY?

Exchange participants can stay for any period from one to 12 months.

#### WHO CAN APPLY?

To be eligible, applicants must:

- · be 20 to 30 years of age; and
- be Canadian citizens
- have an adequate knowledge of and working experience in the area of training requested.

### How Do I APPLY?

The program operates year-round according to availability of exchange opportunities in the host countries.

## INTERNATIONAL AGRICULTURAL EXCHANGE ASSOCIATION (IAEA)

## WHAT IS IT?

Since 1963, IAEA bas, in co-operation with the Canadian Host Family Association, operated exchange programs in agriculture for young men and women from 18 different countries. It is a non-profit organization open to all rural people.

The main objectives of IAEA are:

- to provide rural youth with an opportunity to learn about agricultural methods in other parts of the world;
- to develop an understanding of the culture of other countries; and
- to strengthen and improve mutual understanding between the countries involved through personal contacts established between the participants and the host family.

IAEA has opportunities in Australia, New Zealand, Japan, the United Kingdom and Europe.

### HOW LONG CAN I STAY?

Programs vary from six to 13 months, depending on the host country.

#### WHO CAN APPLY?

To be eligible, applicants must:

- · be 18 to 30 years of age; and
- have at least two years' experience in agriculture.
