U.S. TRADE REPRESENTATIVE CARLA HILLS TO MEET
TRADE MINISTER CROSBIE IN OTTAWA, AUGUST 30, 1989

U.S. Trade Representative Carla Hills will meet with International Trade Minister John Crosbie on the afternoon of August 30, in Ottawa, to review positions and strategies for the substantive phase of the Uruguay Round of Multilateral Trade Negotiations (MTN).

The meeting will cover all major aspects of the negotiations, including agricultural trade reform, subsidies and countervail, market access, and trade in services.

The meeting will also give the U.S. Trade Representative an opportunity to comment on Canada's position paper on subsidies and countervail, which was tabled in Geneva on June 28.

The Ottawa meeting is part of Canada's ongoing bilateral consultations aimed at gaining substantial results in the Uruguay Round, which is scheduled to conclude by the end of 1990. Over the coming months, Mr. Crosbie will be discussing the MTN with his counterparts in Europe and the Pacific Rim.
