The House resumed the adjourned Debate on the proposed motion of Mr. Bennett: That it be resolved,—That it is expedient that Parliament do approve of the Trade Agreement entered into at Ottawa the 20th day of August, 1932, between representatives of His Majesty's Government in Canada and of His Majesty's Government in the United Kingdom, and that this House do approve of the same, subject to the legislation required in order to give effect to the fiscal changes consequent thereto.

And the Debate continuing; the said Debate was, on motion of Mr. Dupré, adjourned.

The House then adjourned at 5.44 o'clock, p.m., until to-morrow, at 3 o'clock, p.m.
