GREETING:

A PROCLAMATION

W HEREAS Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth the Second was graciously pleased by a Commission under the Great Seal of Canada, bearing date the first day of August, 1959, and in the eighth year of Her Majesty's Reign, to appoint Major-General George Philias Vanier, to be Governor General and Commander-in-Chief of Canada.

Whereas no new Commission has been granted superseding the said Commission to the said Major-General George Philias Vanier, appointing him to be Governor General and Commander-in-Chief of Canada, and the said Commission remains in full force and effect.

Whereas by Clause VIII of the Letters Patent bearing date the eighth day of September, 1947, constituting the office of Governor General and Commander-in-Chief of Canada, it is provided that in the event of the incapacity of the Governor General, all and every the powers and authorities therein granted to him shall, until Her Majesty's further pleasure is signified therein, be vested in the Chief Justice for the time being of Canada, who, while such powers and authorities are vested in him, shall be known as Administrator.

AND WHEREAS by reason of the incapacity of the said Major-General The Right Honourable George Philias Vanier to exercise the powers and authorities of Governor General of Canada for the period extending from twelve o'clock noon this sixteenth day of May, 1963, until six o'clock p.m. of this same day and under and in virtue of the Letters Patent all and every the powers and authorities by the said Letters Patent have become vested in me as being the Chief Justice for the time being of Canada, and having taken the necessary Oath as required by the said Letters Patent, I have therefore thought fit to issue this Proclamation to make known the same, and I do hereby require and command that all and singular Her Majesty's Officers and Ministers in Canada do continue in the execution of their several and respective offices, places and employments, and that Her Majesty's loving subjects and all others whom these Presents may concern do take notice thereof and govern themselves accordingly.

GIVEN under my Hand and Seal at Arms at Ottawa, this sixteenth day of May, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty-three and in the twelfth year of Her Majesty's Reign.
