PRAYERS.

Mr. Macdonald (Rosedale) for Mr. Marchand, a Member of the Queen's Privy Council, laid upon the Table,—(1) Copy of Agreement, dated April 21, 1970, between the Government of Canada and the Government of the Province of Newfoundland, with respect to Special Areas and Highways.—Sessional Paper No. 5/300.

(2) Copy of Agreement, dated April 21, 1970, between the Government of Canada and the Government of the Province of New Brunswick, with respect to Special Areas and Highways.—Sessional Paper No. 5/250.

Mr. Skoberg, seconded by Mr. Nystrom, by leave of the House, introduced Bill C-207, An Act to amend the Railway Act (Notice of Accidents), which was read the first time and ordered to be printed and ordered for a second reading at the next sitting of the House.

The Order being read for the report stage of Bill C-10, An Act to amend the Canada Shipping Act, as reported (with an amendment) from the Standing Committee on Health, Welfare and Social Affairs;
