## Proceedings on Adjournment Motion

There are other references which I could quote—for instance, on October 23 at pages 510 and 511 of *Hansard*—which bear out the same facts. There were many factors involved in the situation at that time. Perhaps in retrospect, and with 20-20 hindsight, one might say that

the actions were not justified, but one could also conclude that it was the firm action of the government at that time that prevented our worst fears from being justified.

Motion agreed to and the House adjourned at 10.20 p.m.
