

Library of Parliament.---*Concluded.*

2. Select Committee appointed and Message to Senate informing their Honours thereof, to act as members of a Joint Committee of both Houses on the Library, 36. Message from Senate naming members, on their part, of Joint Committee, 73. **FIRST REPORT**, recording extreme regret at the recent sudden death of Dr. Alpheus Todd, for many years Librarian of the Parliament of Canada; certain recommendations relative to transfer of bulk of Law Books to Supreme Court Building; to the organization of a section of Cartography; and that wire screens be extended to the principal sections on the ground floor, 247-8. **SECOND REPORT**, recommending a Standing Order relative to MSS.; to a second edition of Dr. Todd's work on Parliamentary Government; appointment of Mr. Thayne on permanent Staff; and Rules in reference to loaning books to the public, 435. **FIRST REPORT** referred back, 437. **SECOND REPORT** concurred in, 462. **THIRD REPORT** (**FIRST REPORT** amended), with Report of Sub-committee of Audit, etc., 543-545. Motion that House do go into Committee to consider a Resolution authorizing the Governor in Council to raise, by way of Loan, such sum of money not exceeding two million pounds sterling, etc., and also such further sums not exceeding three million pounds sterling, etc.; His Excellency's recommendation signified; House to go into Committee: Sir Leonard Tilley, 584. In Committee; Resolutions adopted, 600. Reported; concurred in and Bill (No. 156) to authorize the raising, by way of Loan, of certain moneys required for the Public Service; presented, 611. Read second time; considered in Committee; reported; read third time; passed, 629. Passed by the Senate, 634. Royal Assent, 640.—47 Victoria, Chapter 3.
