A Message was received from the Senate informing the House that the Senate had passed the following Bill to which the concurrence of this House is desired.

Bill S-8, An Act respecting the use of national safety marks in relation to motor vehicle tires and to provide for safety standards for certain motor vehicle tires imported into or exported from Canada or sent or conveyed from one province to another—(Mr. Macdonald).

Bill C-81, An Act for granting to Her Majesty certain sums of money for the public service for the financial year ending 31st March, 1975, was again considered in Committee of the Whole and progress having been made and reported, the Committee obtained leave to consider it again at the next sitting of the House.
