make it siccar for you!"

15. Sae they liftit the siller, and did as they war tell't; and this tale was spread abreid amang the Jews—aye, e'en till this day.

16. And the eleeven disciples gaed awa intil Galilee, till a mountain whaur

Jesus had trystit them.

17. And, a seein him, they adored him:

hoobeit, some swither't.

18. And Jesus, drawin nar, spak till them, sayin, "Thar has been gien till me a' pooer in Heeven, and on yirth!

19. "Gang ye thar-for, and mak ye disciples o' a' the nations, bapteezin them intil the name o' the Faither, and o' the Son, and o' the Holie Spirit;

20. "Schawin them hoo till observe a' things, e'en as mony as I hae commandit

21. "And behauld! I am wi' ye a' the days; e'en till a' time!"

a V. 17. Paul tells thar war mair nor fyve hunder o' them, (I. Cor. 15: 6.) I canna think ony o' them wad continue to swither and doot. But the ferlie o' his Risin-again was sae great, they bude hae time to lat the truth get fairly haud o' them!
