

THE GREAT RAILROAD BUBBLE BURST!

HURRAH FOR ST. JAMES'S WARD!

At a Meeting of the Electors of St. James's Ward, called by the Directors of the Railroad Company, last evening, **FRIDAY**, at Wilson's Inn, Church Street, **J. BELL, Esq.** in the Chair, **Mr. C. STOTESBURY, Secretary,**

It was moved by Captain **LEE**, seconded by **Mr. A. B. TOWNLEY, Land Agent,**

"That the proposed Railroad, under our present shortness of Capital, is performing the greatest possible benefit in this Province at the least possible risk of loss, by opening the **TORONTO, SIMCOE AND HURON RAILROAD.**"

It was then moved in amendment, and **CARRIED BY AN IMMENSE MAJORITY,**

"That this meeting is entirely opposed to paying any tax towards the construction of the Toronto, Simcoe and Huron Railroad; and that they are decidedly of opinion that it is unjust and oppressive to compel the Inhabitants of this City to contribute towards such Railroad by a tax when none but the great Landholders, Speculators and unemployed Adventurers are likely to be benefitted by it.

The following Resolution was then moved and seconded, and upon being put from the Chair **CARRIED BY AN OVERWHELMING MAJORITY.**

"That the Electors of St. James's Ward, in public Meeting assembled, call upon their Representatives in the City Council—namely, **J. G. Howes, Esq., Alderman,** and Messrs. **R. James & E. Bell, Councilmen**—to attend in their places at the Council Board to watch over the interests of the Electors by opposing any law having for its object the imposition of a tax for the construction of the said Railroad; otherwise to resign at once the seats they now occupy in the Common Council.
