

The Ballad "Langemarck" which gives the title to this booklet depicts the most heroic incident in Canadian history where the first Canadian Division held the line against fearful odds, when the deadly German gas was used for the first time in modern warfare. The poem is re-printed from "Poems of the Great War," edited by Professor Cunliffe, for the Belgian Relief Fund; Selected Poems of the War, 1915-16, by Professor Clarke, and the latest volume of "The Library of the World's Best Literature."
