EUROPE TO DRAIN
AMERICA'S WHEATGrain Prices Bid Up at Chi-
cago on Export
Talk.

CHICAGO, April 25.—Expert talk today gave wheat a net uplift of 1/4c to 1/2c. Corn at the close was unchanged to 1/4c off, oats suffered a net decline of 1/4c to 1/2c, and provisions closed 1/4c to 1/2c lower.

Renewal of discussion concerning large needs for wheat in Europe and estimates that a great part of it must with the European situation as it is, come from America, was accompanied with specific statements that more than a million and a half bushels had been worked in the heavy days for export from New York. Fears that some harm to growing wheat had come from frosts last night in Nebraska, Kansas and Western Iowa and Missouri, added to bullish sentiment, as did the unsettled European political situation brought about by the Scutari incident. The market showed strength nearly all day, temporary depressions on profit-taking being followed by good rallies. July showed a bit of weakness just at the close, but May held steady. The Argentine situation was a feature in the day's influences. A cut of 8,000,000 bushels in the Argentine visible was noted.

Primary receipts of wheat today were 324,000 bushels against 289,000 bushels last year.

Declines at Kansas City and Omaha depressed corn here. Expectation of larger offerings also had a weakening tendency. Oats eased off on a large increase in receipts.

Selling pressure wiped out the small advance scored by provisions, the start and the entire list closed weak.
