BILL 3.

An Act respecting the use of Flags.

HIS Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:—

- 1. No person shall publicly mutilate, trample upon, Mutilation and deface of treat contemptuously any flag authorised to be ment of flags used in the British Empire, whether such flag is public or prohibited. private property.
- 2. No person shall display any such flag, or any repre-Display of sentation thereof, on which appears any word, figure, defaced flags to advertisement or design of any nature whatsoever.
- 4. Any person violating any provision of section 1 of this Penalty. Act shall be guilty of an offence and liable, on summary 15 conviction, to a fine of not less than fifty dollars and not more than five hundred dollars, or to imprisonment not exceeding thirty days, or to both fine and imprisonment. Each day during which the offence continues shall be deemed to be a separate offence.
- of this Act shall be guilty of an offence and liable, on summary conviction, to a fine of not less than ten dollars and not more than fifty dollars, or to imprisonment not exceeding thirty days, or to both fine and imprisonment. Each day 25 during which the offence continues shall be deemed to be a separate offence.
