HIGHWAY'S DELAY CAUSES BIG LOSS

Dilatormess in Construction Objected to by Hamilton Council.

FILLS WASHED OUT Investigation May Be Asked Into Methods of Roadmaking.

By a Staff Reporter. HAMILTON, Wednesday, Oct. 13.—Many members of the city council, including Mayor Walters, city engineer and Ald. Dr. Hopkins, say that sufficient progress has not been made with the Toronto and Hamilton highway and that owing to the inability of the contractors to carry on some of the work thousands of dollars have been lost and thousands more will be lost before the work is completed.

At last night's city council meeting Mayor Walters asked that a report be requested to make a report at once into the methods of roadmaking which have been used in the work done so far. He said in view of the fact that Hamilton had subscribed \$250,000 to the highway, and that some of the local officials had done much to further the building of the highway, the city was entitled to ascertain why greater progress had not been made with the road. He stated that in some places where fills had been made the earth has been washed away, and that in places where they will have to be replaced at a considerable loss. While the portions of the road now completed are entirely satisfactory, the local officials say that much more should be done to complete it and it is probable that the highway commission will be asked to investigate why greater progress has not been made.

To Report on Work. The local engineers, along with Controller Jutten, member of the commission, will make a report of the work at the next council meeting.

At the request of Ald. R. M. Roy, chairman of the works committee, the recommendation that permission be granted to the E. T. Wright Co. to establish a siding into its factory, along Kelly street, was referred back for further consideration.

Permission was granted to J. Laing & Sons, canvas manufacturers, to erect a new plant on the corner of Main and Cope streets. This is in the restricted zone.

The board of control was authorized to have plans prepared for a temporary heating plant for the Mount Hamilton Hospital, at a cost of \$4200, and for a permanent heating plant at an estimated cost of \$20,000.

To Issue War Loans. Owing to the increased expenditures, the Wentworth County Council yesterday decided to issue war debentures. Councilors Bertman and Mahoney made the motion: "That, in view of the large amounts expended by this county for insurance, for soldiers, machine guns, other war expenditures, and in view of the further amounts that we will be asked upon for before the end of the year, which will leave a large overdraft after all these amounts are received for 1915, we, the Council of Wentworth County, do hereby authorize the county solicitor to prepare a plan for the issue of war debentures, the purpose of taking care of all expenditures made for war purposes, in accordance with the act in that behalf.

Overdraft Grows. The treasurer reported that the overdraft amounted to \$114,144, as against \$67,783.21 for the same time last year. The extra expenditure was caused by the machine gun donations and other expenditures, due to the war.

To Build Factory. The W. T. Rawleigh Company of Freeport, Ill., has decided to build a factory at Hamilton, making the existing factory for this city this year, according to the city industrial commissioner. Matters were brought to a head a few days ago, when the president of the company, W. T. Rawleigh, who had been here for over a week looking over the situation, purchased a two-acre site in the east end of the city, on Rossley street, just north of Barton street, where a siding can be had from the Toronto, Hamilton & Buffalo Railway.

The new sidewalk on Oakwood avenue was also complained about. It was decided to write the York Township Council's engineer to inspect same.
