ARTICLE VII.

The King of Great Britain shall restore to France the Island of St. Lucia, and shall cede and guaranty to her that of I obago.

ARTICLE VIII.

The Most Christian King shall reftore to Great Britain the Islands of Grenada and the Grenadines, St. Vincent's, Dominica, St. Christopher's, Nevis, and Montserrat; and the fortreffes of those islands, conquered by the arms of Great Britain and by those of France, shall be restored in the same condition in which they were when the conquest of them was made; provided that the term of eighteen months, to be computed from the time of the ratification of the definitive treaty, shall be granted to the respective fubjects of the Crowns of Great Britain and France who may have fettled in the faid iflands, and in other places which shall be restored by the definitive treaty, to fell their estates, recover their debts, and to transport theireffects, and retire, without being reftrained on account of their religion, or any other pretence whatever, except in cafes of debt, or of criminal profecutions.
