Omaha, Aug. 16.—Possibly one of

the best evidences that the telephone

is getting to the investigating stage

was the action of the representatives

of the Bell Telephone monopoly yester-

day and the day before in trying to

get members of the city council out

of the city. Certain individuals were

paid for themselves and such others

council to go to Milwaukee and remain

there awhile. The proposition, includ-

ing a stop at the Fair with them as

long as they will stay, and every bill

will be paid, no matter what it in-

cludes.

Humane Society's Work.

During last month the special officer

of the Toronto Humane Society, J.

C. Smith, has investigated 107 cases

of cruelty to animals. A number of

reports reached the office in refer-

ence to the overloading and ill-treatment

of horses used in places where excavat-

ing was being carried on. These cases

were promptly attended to and when

the necessary action taken. The officer in-

spected 49 lame horses and 32 suffering

from sore shoulders, etc., and a num-

ber of these have been laid off work

until better. Two dogs and the same

number of cats were destroyed during

the month. A horse, which was com-

pletely unfit for work was also de-

stroyed. The society earnestly re-

quests any one witnessing cruelty to

animals to report it to the office, 103 Bay-street.
