GOOD CATTLE ARE A SHADE HIGHER

Lambs Lower, Calves Steady, Hogs Look Weak.

With around 1800 cattle on sale yester lay the market did a little better than are not any too many of this class—not mough, indeed—and the market for this class is a good quarter higher in our esti-

enough, indeed—and the market for this class is a good quarter higher in our estimation, and more would sell well.

On the other hand, the common stuff, is increasingly hard to sell, and it takes a lot of hard work on the part of the commission houses to get it worked off at all. They are earning their money these days. The buil trade is weak and low, no good buils coming and none wanted.

The stocker and feeder trade, while not particularly active, is fair to good, considering the big impending changes in government control across the border, and the natural hesitancy on the part of the farmers to stock up. However, they are going ahead on the assumption that the people must be fed, and no outstanding drastic changes are likely. The commission housed dealing almost exclusively in this class of cattle report a fair trade all week, with a steady market, and the builk of the offering; going out to Ontario points, with odd lots across the line.

The lamb trade got a black eye yesterday for some reason or other, and sold off from 50c to 75c a cwt., the builk of the sales going out at 13c. The sheep trade held steady, 7c to 8c a lb.

With a fair run of lambs the market was slow and from 50c to 75c lower. Choice sheep 7c to 8c, heavy sheep and buck yearlings sold from 9c to 19c and choice 5½c to 6½c. The market was very weak at the close.

With a light run of calves-the market

yesterday, one load of extra choice costing % c, the balance around 13c; sheep, 7c to 7%c.
