they shall be continued in office until other representatives are appointed.

3. In the case of a vacancy occurring in the representation by death, resignation, refusal to act, or otherwise, such vacancy may be filled at a special meeting called for that purpose by the Bishop or Sub-Dean, as provided in the next preceding section.

4. The Bishop shall preside at every such meeting; but if he shall be unable to attend, or if the See be vacant, the persons present, and qualified to vote, may appoint a Chairman, and proceed to the election.

5. Public notice of every such meeting, whether ordinary or special, shall be given at the next previous Sunday's service, and also by a notice written or printed affixed to the door of the Cathedral Church at least ten days before the day of such meeting, specifying the time and place of such meeting.

6. All male persons of the age of twenty-one years, being stated attendants at public worship in the Cathedral Church six months next preceding the election, and having been regular contributors to the funds of the said Cathedral, shall be entitled to vote for such Lay Representatives; provided that before any person shall be entitled to vote, he shall, if required by the Chairman or any qualified voter, take and subscribe the following declaration :—

"I, A. B., do declare that I am a member of the Church of England, and belong to no other religious denomination, and that I am duly qualified to vote as provided for in the section of the 17th Article of the Constitution of the said Cathedral Church, and similarly qualified, may also be elected at the same time, and that the certificate of the election of delegates shall also contain the names of the substitutes; and in the case the delegates elected shall be unable to attend the annual or any other meeting by reason of sickness or any other cause, that such substitutes shall take their places, and sit and vote in the Synod as if they had been elected delegates."

That at the time of the election of Lay Delegates, substitutes, not exceeding the number of Lay Delegates for the said Cathedral Church, and similarly qualified, may also be elected at the same time, and that the certificate of the election of delegates shall also contain the names of the substitutes; and in the case the delegates elected shall be unable to attend the annual or any other meeting by reason of sickness or any other cause, that such substitutes shall take their places, and sit and vote in the Synod as if they had been elected delegates.
