Sir

I have the honor to state in reply to official letter dated 15th inst, that the water front applied for by Mr W. Gibbon is that authorized by official letter No. 1319 dated 20th March 1878 to be sold to David Miller for \$250⁰⁰, comprising the water fronts of No. 20 Water Street and No 20 Robinson Street Shaftesbury.

Mr Gibbon produced in his office an agreement signed by Mr E. S. Clarkson assignee of the Estate of David Miller, selling the right of Miller in the water front to Gibbon, and has paid \$100⁰⁰ on account of purchase.

Since the application for an extension of time for payment was made by Mr Gibbon and application from Captain P. M. Campbell has been received, to buy the water front in question, the application is also a letter from Miss Moberly and Gammon is herewith enclosed.

From the letter of Miss Moberly and Gammon it appears that the water front has been mortgaged by David Miller
