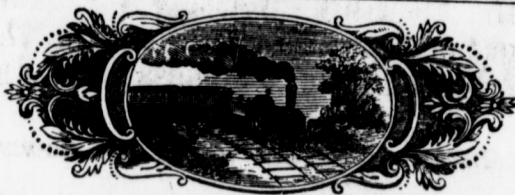


NORTHERN RAILWAY OF CANADA.

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CONNECTIONS.

1. **TORONTO.**—Trains connect with Grand Trunk and Great Western Trains for HAMILTON and SUSPENSION BRIDGE.
2. **KING.**—Stages daily to BOND'S LAKE.
3. **AURORA.**—Stage daily to LLOYDTOWN.
4. **BRADFORD.**—Stage daily to BOND HEAD and COOKSTOWN.
5. **BARRIE.**—Stage daily to ORILLIA; and Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Saturdays, to PENETANGUISHENE. Trains stop at BARRIE for refreshments.
6. **COLLINGWOOD.**—Steamer *Clifton*, and Stage daily to THORNBURY, MEAFORD, CAPE RICH, and OWEN SOUND.
