

CONSTITUTION AND BYE-LAWS
OF THE
NEW BRUNSWICK
PROVINCIAL RIFLE ASSOCIATION.

CONSTITUTION.

1. This Association shall be called "The New Brunswick Provincial Rifle Association."
2. Any person being a British subject, subscribing two dollars to the funds of the Association shall be a member thereof for the year in which such subscription shall be made.
3. A contribution of twenty dollars, or of the value thereof, to the Association shall constitute the donor a life member.
4. County and Regimental Associations subscribing ten dollars and upwards per annum towards the funds of the Association shall be considered as being in connection therewith, and shall be entitled to a number of memberships in the proportion of one to every dollar so subscribed. The subscribing Association to elect from among its members the persons to hold such memberships. In Counties where County or Regimental Associations are not formed, Volunteer Companies, Troops or Batteries, upon payment of five dollars and upwards to the Association, to be allowed five or more memberships in like manner. Members not to be eligible by virtue of such membership to participate in the management of the affairs of the Association, nor shall commissioned Officers be entitled to such memberships.
5. On payment of any subscription or contribution, tickets of membership shall be issued by the Secretary, which shall contain the name of the member, and shall not be transferable.
6. No Officer, Non-commissioned Officer or private of the Militia of New Brunswick, not being a member or an affiliated member of the Association, shall be allowed to compete for any prizes except "All Comers," under its control.
