Synopsis of Canadian Northwest  
Land Regulations.

ANY person who is the sole need of a  
family or any number of persons may  
be interested in a quarter section of avail-  
able Dominion land in Manitoba,  
Saskatchewan, or Alberta. The applicant  
must appear in person at the Dominion  
Lands Agency or Sub-Agency for the dis-  
trict, bring by proxy any in made at any  
agency, on certain conditions, by father,  
mother, son, daughter, brother or sister of  
the applicant.

In certain districts a homesteader in  
good standing may pre-empt a quarter sec-  
tion alongside his homestead. Price \$3.00  
per acre. Duties—Must reside on the land  
each of six years from date of homestead  
entry (including the time required to earn  
homestead patent) and cultivate fifty acres  
extra.

A homesteader may live within five  
miles of his homestead on a farm of at  
least 80 acres solely owned and occupied by  
him or by his father, mother, son, daugh-  
ter, brother or sister.

In certain districts a homesteader in  
good standing may pre-empt a quarter sec-  
tion alongside his homestead. Price \$3.00  
per acre. Duties—Must reside on the land  
each of six years from date of homestead  
entry (including the time required to earn  
homestead patent) and cultivate fifty acres  
extra.

A homesteader who has exhausted his  
homestead right and cannot obtain a pre-  
emption may enter for a purchased home-  
stead in certain districts. Price \$3.00 per  
acre. Duties—Must reside on the land  
each of six years from date of homestead  
entry (including the time required to earn  
homestead patent) and cultivate fifty acres  
extra.
