IS INVESTED AS DOMESTIC PRELATE

Unusual and Deeply Impressive Ceremony in Holy Trinity Church—Presentation to Very Rev. Mgr. J. J. Walsh.

A very interesting and impressive ceremony took place last evening in Holy Trinity Church, when the pastor, Very Rev. Monsignor J. J. Walsh, was invested with the Domestic Prelacy of Home by His Lordship Bishop LeBlanc. His parishioners took the opportunity of reading to him a congratulatory address and presenting to him a well-filled purse. Vespers and the rosary were conducted by Rev. Simon Oram and, after preaching an inspiring sermon, Very Rev. Mgr. Walsh, robed in his miter, celebrated Benediction of the Most Blessed Sacrament.

In the presence of a large number of the parishioners of Holy Trinity parish His Lordship Bishop LeBlanc, upon entering the sanctuary, handed the papal brief to Monsignor Walsh, and, addressing the congregation, he referred to the fact that only those who had performed deserving services received this great honor and that he wanted to give public testimony to the fact that Monsignor Walsh had rendered very considerable services to the church and to him, personally, especially in his early days as Bishop of St. John diocese, both by his sound advice and by his intimate knowledge of the canons of the church government. The honor had also been bestowed in recognition of his profound theological attainments. He said that he joined with the people of the congregation in congratulating the new monsignor and he concluded by expressing the hope that he would be with them for many years.

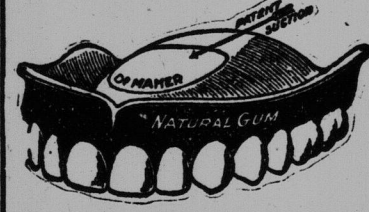
This was followed by the Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament, celebrated by Very Rev. Monsignor Walsh in the presence of the bishop.

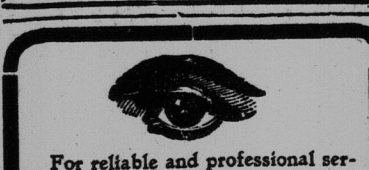
What appears to have been a shrine of the prehistoric people of New Mexico has lately been discovered and is now being explored by a party from the American Museum of Natural History. It is a sealed room in the Pueblo ruin at Aztec, New Mexico.

Dr. Clark Wissler, curator of the Museum's department of anthropology, makes this report on the discovery: "The room is in perfect condition. The interior is plastered and painted in a brilliant white with dull red side borders and a running series of triangular designs. No room approaching this in beauty and perfection has ever been discovered in America. There are several adjoining rooms that seem to have some relation to this, but it will be some time before they can be dug out.

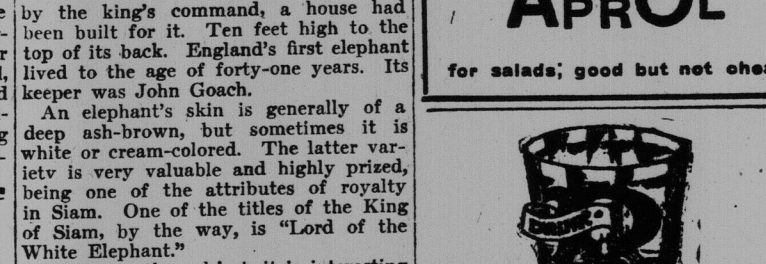

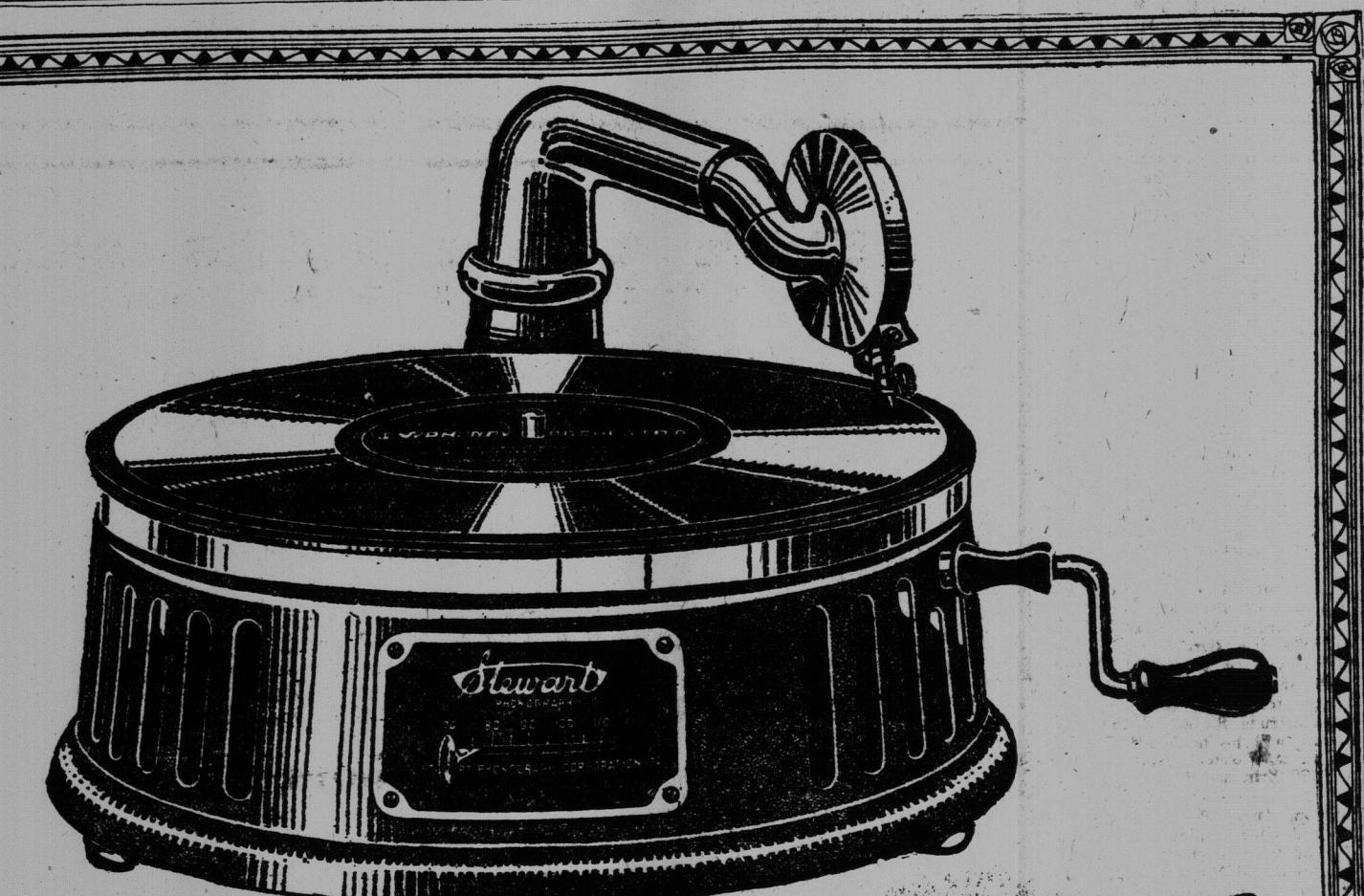
