PRESIDENT GARFIELD'S ASSASSIN AT THE BAR OF JUSTICE--EXTRAORDINARY SCENE IN COURT--DIFFERENCES BETWEEN THE COUNSEL OF THE PRISONER--STRANGE CONDUCT OF THE ACCUSED.

WASHINGTON, Nov. 14, 1881. By a hurried drive of the "van Guitau" was carried from the jail to the court building at half-past eight o'clock this morning.

There was the usual scramble for front seats by the crowd, the personnel of which hardly differed from that usually seen in a criminal court on any case involving local or public interest in being tried.

Of the five jurors selected, three are reported to be Democrats. One of the number is an ex-Methodist preacher. Three of them have never had a lawsuit and none have ever served on a petit jury.
