The great Powers will make certain concessions to the Balkan allies in an endeavor to bring about peace. They have agreed on the reply that is to be made to the objections which the allies offered to the bases for mediation as proposed by the Powers.  
The concession to Bulgaria is acceptance of her proposal that the frontier of the Ottoman Empire shall be a straight line between Enos and Midia instead of following the course of the Ergene and Maritza rivers, as the Powers first suggested.
