last night, Sir John Macdonald was
unanimously nominated for the vacancy
made by Crawford's acceptance of Gov-
ernorship.
It is hardly likely he will accept.
Should he refuse, Walter Shanley will
probably be the candidate.

Ottawa, Nov. 12.
The Reform League here, after failing
to start a paper, profess to have bought
the Times. This morning it announces
its change of proprietorship, and
holds the Reform flag under the manage-
ment of Rogers and McLeod, the former
being Conservative and the latter
an Ottawa legislator of the Toronto
Club.
Peter Mitchell has received a testi-
monial, signed by nearly 200 members
of the League, on the northern New Brun-
swick coast, expressing gratitude for the
precautions he has taken to protect
life and property during the late terrific
storms, in which almost their entire fish-
fleet were lost, they reaching shelter
without the loss of life, owing to lights
being placed on dangerous points since
Mr. Mitchell has been Minister of Mar-
ine. He will oppose the Government
with his usual energy, and his successor
will have rather a hard time of it.
There is a dead lock in politics, the only
interest being in the preparation for the
grand banquet to-night.
