CENTENNIAL PERFORMING ARTS  
ALLOCATION OF GRANTS

Answer to Inquiry by Hon. Donald Cameron:  
1. What is the total amount of money allocated by the Government of Canada for the Centennial Performing Arts grants?

Three million eight hundred thousand dollars (\$3,800,000.00).

2 and 3. What is the allocation by provinces?

The budget is not apportioned by provinces, but it is hoped that when all the money is finally allocated, it will somewhat relate to proportionate distributions by provincial population. At the present time the budget is broadly divided as follows:
