Sir I was called on this day to go  
and have a line between James McQuinn and  
and McQuinn and James McQuinn's land as they  
was in dispute about their line about the timber  
as Quinn said that Popper was a game to make  
timber back on his lot and I found Popper's  
were still making on my land where he  
said you give him a lease for land and  
he told me you had give him a lease on ground  
McQuinn and James McQuinn to judge their  
lot to face Hundred Acres between the two which  
I found this day that he has crossed from the  
two McQuinn's lot a cross James McQuinn's  
and Quinn's lot and the width of 2 or three  
single lots more in the wilderness and a cross  
my boundary line of my licence and said  
he has taking a lot there in one part of  
my ground to take and take the timber from  
me and only for the sake of the timber not  
for the land and said he has not want the land  
if it was not for the sake of the timber as  
he said he thinks there is timber a plenty to  
pay the lease for five years and for that reason  
where I went this day and saw how it was
