Sir,-

With further reference to your letter of the 23rd July and our reply of the 4th ultimo regarding land required for a road diversion on the Pasqua Indian Reserve, I beg to say the assessment placed on the land required is \$20.00 per acre, a total of \$32.00. You are requested to give an undertaking that you will construct the road as diverted. The above valuation may be considered as damages as it is not intended to give your Company a patent for the lands required for this road diversion as great difficulty has been found heretofore in having the road maintained where the patent has been given to a Railway Company under similar circumstances.
