progress. How appalling it is in some
of its aspects! In my mind it has a
much greater significance than the
Chinese Revolution. It has helped to
demonstrate how those who live on
the top of the earth are dependent
on those who ~~live~~ ^{work} under it, and
has revealed the meaning and the
possibilities of 'the solidarity of labour'
as the world has hitherto never
known it. I believe it marks
a step in progress for the mass
of the people, but it has work
