

Enclose Copy of Surrender No  
 46 made on the 5<sup>th</sup> June '56 by the  
 Chippewas of Lake Huron, Sniwew  
 and Ouchekung of Certain Island  
 named therein, including those in  
 Georgian Bay. By this Surrender  
 you will perceive that it was stipulated  
 that the Islands in Georgian Bay  
 should be sold; the proceeds invested  
 for the benefit of the Indian Owners,  
 and the interest accruing from the  
 capital realized upon such sales  
 paid to them annually.

This Surrender was formally  
 accepted by the Governor in Council  
 (Copy of the Order is enclosed) on  
 the 14<sup>th</sup> July 1856, and on the 3<sup>rd</sup> August  
 of the same year Mr William Massey
