Referring to your letter of the 14th instant, addressed to Mr. Ogilvie, in which you ask for some further information regarding the plan for the Carcross Indian Boarding School, Yukon, sketches of which were left by you some time ago for the purpose of having them examined by the architect of this Department and receiving from him any suggestions that would appear to him as being advisable and in connection with which a letter was sent you on the 13th instant, I beg to say that,-

The cost of steam heating over warm air heating

will be about \$2,000.

The building has been increased in size to provide accommodation for 28 pupils. This has increased the cost over plan you submitted by

2,000.

Providing the building is enlarged to accommodate 40 children cost will be increased by

2,000.
