All and Singular that portion of St. Clair Avenue in
the City of Sarnia, in the County of Lambton and Province of Ontario,
which may be more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at a point in the south limit of St. Clair
Avenue aforesaid distant forty feet (40') when measured westerly at right
angles from the centre line of the main track of the Pere Marquette
Railway, thence westerly along the south limit of St. Clair Avenue
to the water's edge of the River St. Clair, thence northerly along
said water's edge of the River St. Clair to the point where it is
intersected by the north limit of St. Clair Avenue, thence easterly
along said north limit of St. Clair Avenue to a point in the north
limit of St. Clair Avenue which point is distant forty feet (40')
when measured westerly at right angles from the centre line of the
main track of the Pere Marquette Railway, thence southerly and parallel
to the centre line of the main track of the Pere Marquette Railway
to the place of commencement ~~and as shown colored in green on the~~
