Dear Mr. Robinson,

In reply to your letter of the 17th Instant, as to the desire of Miss Quigley to sub-let her lease of the fishing privileges on the Big Hole Indian Reserve, I beg to say that Mr. Superintendent Carter, of Richibucto, has been instructed to allow Miss Quigley to sub-let to any person she may desire, provided he considers there is no objection to the proposed sub-lessee.

The Local Superintendent has also been instructed to grant Miss Quigley the camping privileges desired, provided he knows of no reason against the same.
