

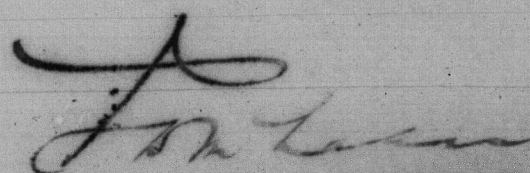

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 23rd instant, in regard to Lot C of Island 139 in the Georgian Bay, and in reply to say that the Department only recently discovered the error made by the Surveyor in connection with the subdivision of Island 139, and as the portion designated 95F has been disposed of, the Department is unable to carry out sale to you of Lot C, except as indicated in letter addressed you on the 7th instant.
