through Indian Reserves, Cariboo road.

Sir:

On behalf of the Honourable the Minister of Public Works, I beg to submit a formal application for a P.C. Order covering the rights of way through the Indian Reserves shown on the accompanying statement. Copies of plans (one tracing, one linen print, and one paper print) together with descriptions of each parcel of land required, have been sent you under separate cover.

I understand from Mr. Ditchburn, Indian Commissioner for B.C., (to whom a copy of this letter is being sent, together with copy of plans) that it is the intention to issue one P.C. Order covering the entire reserves which will be quite satisfactory to us. However, I would advise that there are still two or three rights of way required on the portion of the road between Lytton and Spences Bridge, information on which will be forwarded as soon as received.
