## MEMORANDUM FOR THE PRIME MINISTER:

Re: Select Committee on Honours and Awards

On October the 9th, 1941, the Cabinet War Committee agreed that the subject of honours and awards be referred to a Special Committee of the House of Commons, which would be appointed when Parliament convened, with power to sit during adjournments.

There was no opportunity of appointing the Committee when Parliament last sat. Presumably the government will wish to proceed in the new session.

The attached terms of reference were prepared by the Associate Minister of National Defence.
