

Figure 2. The 30-foot skeleton of Gorgosaurus was taken up in five sections, the largest of which weighed over a ton. The sections, consisting of the bones held in place by the sandstone matrix, were swathed in burdap dipped in plaster of paris, preparatory to being packed in strong boxes and taken by wagon over the prairie to the nearest railway station. In the above view a section is being lifted by block and tackle into the wagon for removal to the prairie level.
