Premier of Manitoba.

BORN Sophiasburg, P.E. County, February 15th, 1853.
Went to Carman, Manitoba, in 1880, where he has
farmed on an extensive scale. For five years Reeve
of Dufferin and two years its Warden; a trustee
of Dufferin School.

Elected for Dufferin to the Manitoba Legislature in 1888.
Premier, Minister of Agriculture and Emigration, and since
1911, Provincial Secretary. President of Council; Provincial
Lands Commissioner and Railway Commissioner for the
Province since 1900. Justice of the Peace for thirty years.
