It is true that exports of Canadian cheese have been adversely affected during the last year or two owing to the increase of the home consump-tion and diversion of milk, and it is tion and diversion of milk, and it is only to be presumed that a more satisfactory price has been forthcom-ing for the milk and cheese than this country has been able to pay. There seems, however, every pros-pect of good prices for cheese during

pect of good prices for cheese during the coming season, because owing to shortage of stocks of Canadian in the winter months all the New Zealands have been required for consumption, and the market should be hungry for the Canadian product during the summer months. It is cretain that this country can take all certain that this country can take all that New Zealand can send as well. because for the land can send as well. because for the land can send as well, because for the last few years there has been a considerable growth in the home make in England, and yet prices have been very high.
