No doubt Canadian farmers are much exercised in their minds as to the future prospects for cheese, seeing that the altered U.S.A. tariff and the large increase in production from New Zealand have made a great deal of difference to the outlook. It is true that exports of Canadian cheese have been adversely affected during the last year or two owing to the increase of the home consumption and diversion of milk, and it is only to be presumed that a more satisfactory price has been forthcoming for the milk and cheese than this country has been able to pay.

There seems, however, every prospect of good prices for cheese during the coming season, because owing to the shortage of stocks of Canadian in the winter months all the New Zealanders have been required for consumption, and the market should be hungry for the Canadian product during the summer months. It is certain that this country can take all the cheese that Canada is likely to be able to make for many years to come, and yet let all the New Zealand can send as well, because for the last few years there has been a considerable growth in the home make in England, and yet prices have been very high.

International Cheese Outlook

Editor, Farm and Dairy,—As far as the Old Country is concerned, there is not much change in the cheese situation. If anything, there is an inclination towards some increase in make. As prices having been fairly remunerative, more land has, from time to time, been laid out for pasture, but we have no information as to whether sufficient has been done in this way to cause any appreciable difference.

We note your remarks regarding the change in the dairy industry in your country. This information has also reached us from other sources, but we are disposed to think that the change is not likely to be as great or acute as some people imagine, because quite recently we have been getting butter from the United States at greatly reduced prices, which shows that there is no shortage there at the present time.

We may state, in passing, that cheese are beginning to be produced in Siberia, and are reaching the London market; and there seems to be an idea that the dairy industry will be steadily developed. It is also a fact that in Australia, particularly Victoria and Queensland, quantities of cheese are being produced, and we are informed that the production will steadily increase. The make of New Zealand cheese during this season has been largely in excess of the previous season, but it has found a ready market here.

On the whole, we think the outlook is for good, but not extravagant, prices throughout the coming season. Lovell & Christmas, Limited, per John C. Lovell, London, England.
