VANCOUVER, B. C.—Plans have been prepared for hotel to be built at Morrissey Mines by N. Hanson, three storeys, electric lighting, billiard room, etc.—A company has been formed to build a large saw mill on the Columbia river, between Trail and Robson.

QUEBEC, QUE.—The Department of Militia has been petitioned to enlarge the drill hall in this city.—Ouellet & Levesque, of this city, are preparing plans for repairs to the church and pastor's residence, and for a new sacristy in the parish of St. Desire du Lac Noir (Black Lake).

ST. MARY'S, ONT.—The Council desire tenders by May 25th for purchase of debentures.—J. A. Humphris, architect, is preparing plans for a two-storey brick grocery store to be built by F. W. Hutton.—Manufacturers of steam road rollers have been requested to submit figures to the Town Council.

THETFORD MINES, QUE.—Work will shortly be commenced on the proposed power plant of the St. Francis Hydraulic Power Co., formed to supply light and power in this vicinity. The power house will be located at the outlet of Lake St. Francis. The superintendent of the company is A. G. Sangster, late of Sherbrooke.

HAMILTON, ONT.—The Superintendent of County Roads has reported that it is necessary to purchase one stone crusher, one road roller, two No. 3 wheel scrapers, two No. 2 scrapers and three large slush scrapers.—Ald. Thomas Allen has purchased property west of the city hospital on which he will build about fifteen houses.—John Thompson is building a brick dwelling on Inebury street.

VANCOUVER, B. C.—St. Paul's church congregation, Jervis street, are considering the erection of a new church.—Plans have been prepared by W. T. Farrell for a suspension bridge to be built over the Capilano Canyon.—The City Engineer has been instructed to obtain figures in England and other places for vitrified pipe, and from British Columbia manufacturers for the supply of paving bricks.

TRURO, N. S.—The council have decided to invite new tenders on amended plans for erection of court house.—The New Brunswick Government has pur-

chased five acres of land adjoining the present Experimental Farm for the establishment of a provincial agricultural college, to be 100 x 55 feet, with an ell 30 x 40 feet, main building of wood with stone basement, and wing of brick, cost about \$30,000.

B.—The Dominion Government is asking for tenders by May 11th for erection of residence in this city for the Sargeant-Major, also for the erection of officers' stables.—The Maine and New Brunswick Electrical Power Co. is seeking incorporation, the applicants including John E. Stewart, James E. Porter and Hiram D. Stevens. It is proposed to develop water power on the Aroostook river.
