**DISAPPOINTED**

(Courier Leased Wire). LONDON, Jan. 24.—The London Stock Exchange was greatly disappointed about the Turkish crisis today. A prolongation of the recent uncertainty was feared, and quotations were marked down in all directions, more principally speculative issues. American falls opened from \$1 to \$3 below parity, while Rio Tintos 2 1/2 points and Turkish bonds were 1 1/2 points down. Consols were quoted 1/4 lower on local selling, due to fears that the Continental markets may unload heavily. Later in the day the market appeared to be a shade steadier and with a hardening tendency, although it was still unsettled.
