NEW BRUNSWIGK POTATO CROP

Reports received from New Brunscent less than that of 1922. In some friction will be inevitable the Victoria district the potato during the period of transition from acreage was 10 per cent less than one currency to the other, that of 1922. The price received at the present time is \$1.40 to \$1.50 per barrel of 165 pounds.

East Centreville—The acreage planted to potatoes in this district is 70 per cent of that of last year with a yield of around 100 barrels per acre; which is slightly more in the aggregate than the crop of 1922. The condition is good as regards quality and disease. 80 per cent of the potatoes are still in the hands of the grower. The price of potatoes at this time is \$1..25 to \$1.50 per barrel of \$65# pounds.


