The newspapers say that thousands of tons of munitions on the French steamship "Mont Blanc" exploded in the harbor at 9 a.m. yesterday as a result of a collision with the Belgian relief ship "Imo." Aconservative estimate is, eight hundred killed, thousands injured, millions of dollars of property destroyed and damaged in the northern part of Halifax, known as Richmond. Many fires. The situation is reported under control The collision occurred in the Narrows leading from the harbor into Bedford Basin. The greatest loss of life is in the Richmond district. There is much suffering among the homeless. The temperature is below freezing. The telegraph and telephone wires were all down for
