

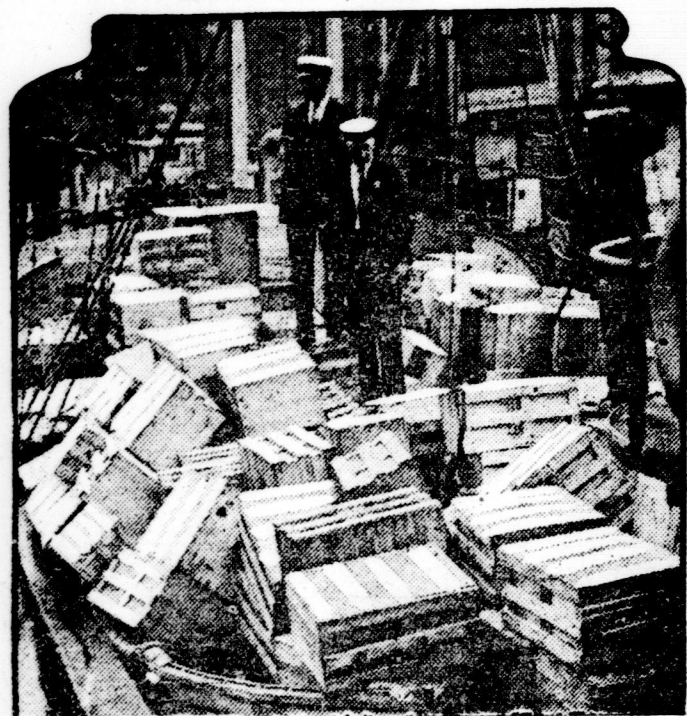

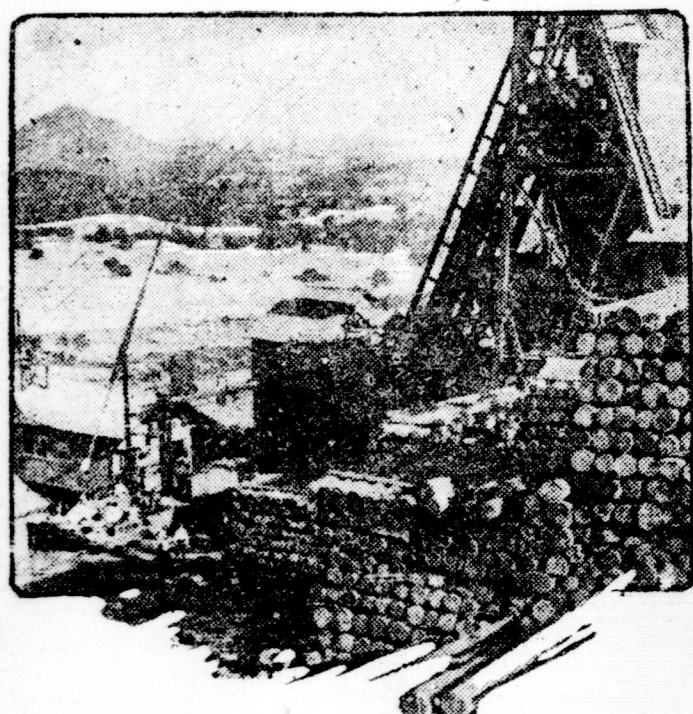

Burial of Irish Martyr



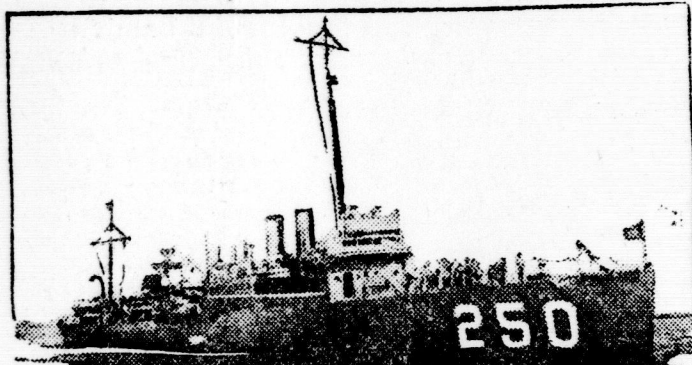
FLAG-DRAPEd gun carriage bearing the body of the slain Irish leader, Michael Collins, to its last resting place in Dublin Cemetery.
