WATFORD MILK

1. HEALTHY COWS.

Pure milk can only come from healthy cows. Much of the tuberculosis, especially in children, can be traced to milk from tubercular cows. In all towns like Watford, where milk goes directly from the cow to the consumer, without being sterilized, the cows should be given the tuberculin test.

To safeguard you we have had our whole herd tested by the Department of Agriculture through Dr. McGillicuddy and can guarantee every cow free from tuberculosis. This means much to you when you consider that tuberculosis is very common in dairy herds, and often the healthiest-looking cow is full of germs.

Our cows drink well-water the year round. Milk from cows that drink out of polluted streams or mud-holes is not fit for human consumption.

2. CARE OF MILK.

Our cows are cleaned and their udders washed before milking. Clean milking is essential to clean milk. All pails and containers are sterilized. As far as possible we aerate and cool the milk. Milk hot from cows, put into bottles and then sealed, contains all the animal heat which should be taken from it before bottling. In larger places where milk is scientifically sterilized and then cooled the bottling process is the most sanitary. However, we believe that where this cannot be done the small pail is the most sanitary for the following reasons:—(a) The consumer washes and scalds his own pail. (b) The animal heat and gases are allowed to escape through a few small holes in the cover of the pail—which is not possible with the sealed bottle.

We will supply milk, though, in bottles to any who so desire and try as far as possible to cool the milk before bottling. As our business grows we purpose putting in up-to-date aerating and cooling machinery. It is our intention to give you pure milk and rich milk at the lowest possible price, and will deliver milk twice a day so that you may have the fresh milk morning and night.
