The following pronunciations of conmon plant names have been adopted by both the Ontario and Canadian Horticus tural Associations They discard man that are commonly used, and are of it terest to all lovers of flowers:

Agave: a-gâ-ve (a in second syllable \$

in art), not ag'-ave. Aloe: al'-ō-ē, not al'o.

Arbutus, ar'būt-us, not ar-būt'-us Aristolochia, ar-is-tol-ō-kia, not aris

tol-o-chi-a.

klem'-a-tis, not kle mats Clemates nor klem-i'-tis

Cyclamen: sik'-la-men, not si-kla-men Cyperus: si-pe-rus, not si'-per-u-Dahlia: dahl'-i-a (a in first syllable

in art), mot day-le-a.

Deutzia: dôit-zi-a, not doot-zi-a. Edelweiss: a'-del-vis, not idle-wise. Giadiolus, glad'-io-lus, not gladid'la

nor glad-i'-o-lus.

Gypsophila. gip-sof'-il-a, not gip soff's Hemerocallis: he-mer-o-kal'-lis, not be er-o-kal'-lis.

Hydra: -ea; hi-dran'-jē-a (a in seco syllab' in arise), mot hi-dran' ja-a, i hide' a-range.

Kmphofia ni-fo'-fi-a, not ni-fo! a Kochie, kok'-i-a, not kô'sh-a.

Lonicera lon-i-ser'-a, not lon-i era Nephrolepis. ne-fro-lep'-is, not ne-fit cp-is

Enothera, é-no-thé'-ra, not e. Papaver: pa-pā'-ver, not pap'-a-v r. Scabiosa: skā-bi-ō'-sa, not skai-i-ō'-Schizanthus: skiz-an'-thus, no sch an'-thus.

Vase: vāze, not vauze, vāce, ne valu Viola: vi'-o'la, not vī-ol'-a. Weigelia: vi-, or wi-ge'-li-a,

gē'-li-a.
